Orlando International Airport (OIA) BP-409, Rent-A-Car QTA and Support Facilities

The project was to design and construct new and expanded rental car quick turnaround areas (QTA's) and associated improvements to the Terminal A and B rent-a-car facilities at the Orlando International Airport.

The project included expansion, rehabilitation and reconfiguring Terminal A QTA's including new fueling and car wash facilities – Building footprint of 39,955 SF; new Terminal B QTA's including new fueling and car wash facilities – Building footprint of 17,039 SF; conversion of Terminal A Garage QTA to rental car ready return spaces; rental car jockey road improvements; and constructing of service roads inside the Terminal A QTA – Overall QTA Lease Area both A & B Terminals of 1,072,825 SF.

The project also included major modification to pedestrian and roadway directional signs directing passengers to and from thesenew facilities.
