Fiber Optic Network (FON) Locate Services Orlando-Orange County Expressway Authority

GCI's Maintenance Management Consultant services contract with the Orlando-Orange County Expressway Authority (OOCEA 2002 - 2008) included Fiber Optics Network (FON) inspection and locate services. The FON consists of over 200 miles of conduit, duct bank, and power cables. The scope of work included locating, managing, and inspecting existing fiber optic cables and duct banks. These duct banks contain OOCEA's fiber optic communication, data transmission and CCTV cables.



The contract used Florida statutes and Sunshine State One Call of Florida, Inc. polices for the protection of the system and to ensure that there are no conflicts with current or future construction projects. The contract included continuous coordination with other State, County, and City communication companies to ensure uninterrupted operation of the OOCEA FON system.
