ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BP-359, Airside 2 Extension of Wings 7 and 9

This is a Design/Build (D/B) project for capacity improvements at Airside 2 of the Orlando International Airport. The Project included extensions of Wings 7 and 9 and renovations / additions to accommodate gate demand.

This work included the extension of the existing airside wings approximately six structural bays to accommodate six new loading gates and finishing walls, floors and furnishings to match existing set-up, extending the skylight, all support facilities such as mechanical and electrical rooms at the ramp level. The project also included the build-out of tenant offices and storage areas.
