ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BP-362B, Airside 2 Hurricane Damage Restoration

This Design/Build (D/B) project consisted of permanent rehabilitation of Airside 2 at the Orlando International Airport following damages from hurricanes Charley, Frances and Jeanne during the period of August - September 2004. The scope of work was to restore the airside to its pre-hurricane condition.

This work included new roofing for approximately 75% of the Airside 2 structure with new wall, floor and ceiling finishes and furnishings.
