ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT V-218, AGT Structural Steel Painting Airsides 1,2,4

The project consisted of the cleaning, surface preparation, priming, painting, protection of unaffected surfaces, and clean up of the structural and miscellaneous steel surfaces of the AGT systems serving Airsides 1 and 3 and the miscellaneous steel surfaces of the AGT system serving Airside 4. Also included was a protective floor coating for the AGT office and Maintenance Areas and elevated work platforms on the west end of the Landside Terminal.

The scope included was cleaning, preparing, and sealing / waterproofing of the AGT Tube Vault Floors and stemwalls up to the terminal floor level at the Airside Stations for the AGT systems serving Airsides 1 and 3.

To eliminate impact on the public, all work was performed between 11:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. nightly over a 9-month period.
