ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BP-239, Structural Parking Additions

This Design/Build (D/B) project consisted of the construction of structural parking additions, totaling approximately 4,500 spaces, on both the A and B sides of the Orlando International Airport main terminal complex.

This work included structural parking additions on the outer perimeter of the existing structures; ramps from the enplane drives to the fifth level of the existing garages; up and down ramps between levels of the new additions; lighting, fire protection and warning systems; landscaping and irrigation; architectural features; signage and pavement markings; revenue control and maintenance of traffic systems.
