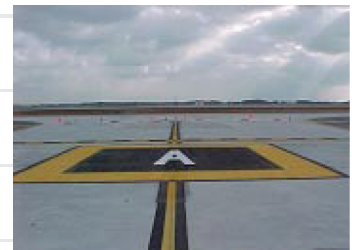

ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BP-330, Site & Infrastructure Improvements for Tradeport and West Airfield Development

This project consists of utility and roadway improvements, taxiway construction and security fence installation to accommodate the West Airfield development at the Orlando International Airport. This project was in support of a new Cessna and flight safety facility.

Included was installation of a new sewer force main, gravity sewer, lift station, storm drainage, and an electrical and communication duct-bank. Construction included turn lanes with signal loops at the intersection of Tradeport and Bear Roads. Installation of a 5900 SF concrete taxiway, 500 LF of Air Operations Area (AOA) security fencing, and taxiway lighting were also included.
