ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BP-446, Ticket Lobby Program – Oversized Baggage and Infrastructure Relocation

This project relocated the numerous existing Transportation Security Administration (TSA) oversize baggage screening areas from Level 3 of the Landside Terminal to Level 2 "behind the scenes", consolidated baggage screening rooms on Level 2 at the Orlando International Airport. All existing screening infrastructure was removed from Level 3 to free up floor space on Level 3 prior to the start of BP-447, Main Ticket Lobby Renovations.



The new TSA screening rooms included laminate wall panels, access and rollup doors, anti-fatigue flooring, roller beds, screening, tables, and CCTV and access control security systems. Also included was the first Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) baggage tracking system.
