ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BP-440, Communications Rooms and Infrastructure Ticket Lobby Modification Program

This project supported current and future technology demands to better accommodate tenant relocations and services. Twelve (12) new and thirteen (13) existing communication rooms were created or remodeled on both Landside(s) A and B. New fiber optic and copper backbone cabling was installed, (including in the Level 2 ceilings), to provide an organization for Landside Level 3 Communication rooms.

The master build-out provided a main communication room and two supporting communication rooms in each quad; four (4) quads for A-Side and four (4) quads for B-Side.
