Orlando Executive Airport (OEA) V-682, Maintenance Facility Relocation (Design/Build)

This project consisted of constructing a new 2,800-sq. ft. Maintenance Facility at the Orlando Executive Airport (OEA), on Rickenbacker Drive, immediately west of the existing OEA Administration and US Customs & Border Protection (CBP) facility. The pre-engineered metal building included an enclosed maintenance bay, a covered and fenced storage area with break room and restroom.

Included in the scope of this project were the relocation of two (2) above ground, double-walled fuel tanks (one diesel and one regular unleaded) and the associated dispensing equipment from their location near the previously demolished maintenance building.
