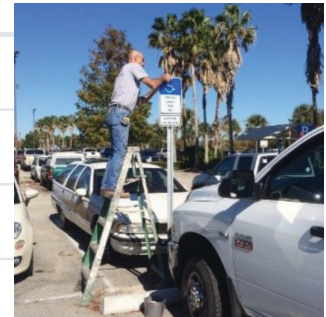

ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT V-666, Miscellaneous Parking Garage ADA Upgrades

This Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) project consisted of the review and modification of all Accessible vehicle parking spaces located in the A & B Garages, Terminal Top Parking Garage and the North and South Park Place economy parking lots at the Orlando International Airport. The purpose of this project was to align parking with current ADA standards as identified by the 2012 Florida Accessibility Code for Building Construction.

Included in the scope of this project was the removal of all existing ADA pavement markings and the installation of current code-compliant pavement markings, removal of existing ADA signage and installation of code-compliant signage. Also included in this project was the addition of concrete wheel stops at the front of all Accessible parking places.
