ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT V-658, Miscellaneous ADA Upgrades at Landside and Airsides

This project upgraded multiple locations within both the Terminal and Airsides to comply with the Americans with Disability Act (ADA) requirements as required by the Department of Justice 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design and the 2012 Florida Accessibility Code for Building Construction.

This work modified or upgraded all information counters at the west end of Landside Levels 2 and 3 to provide an accessible counter area for the public, modified all public phones to an accessible height, provided battery backup to these phones and added video telephones to Landside Level 3 and all Airsides. The project also constructed two (2) wheelchair accessible pet relief areas accessible from both sides of Landside Level 2, added/modified existing items such as coat racks, mirrors, countertops, dispensers, coat hooks, grab bars and other restroom accessories to accessible heights in all restrooms at Landside and Airsides. Finally, the project provided tactile warning surfaces to both sides of the crosswalks at the center of the Terminal, Level 1.
