ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BP-441, Restroom Renovations, Airside 4 Improvement Program

This project renovated or added a total of sixteen (16) public restrooms and three (3) nursing rooms to the transfer level of Airside 4. The restrooms were renovated as pairs, one male and one female per pair, one (1) pair in each wing and three (3) pairs at the hub near the entrance to each wing. One companion restroom in the hub was renovated. Additionally, one (1) companion restroom and one (1) nursing room were added to each wing from space converted from other uses.

The upscale design of each room was developed cooperatively using input from the GOAA Customer Service Initiative and Maintenance Department. Each room included touchless paper towel and soap dispensers, in-counter waste receptacles and larger stalls where space permitted.
